

AT-LARGE MEMBER POSITION OPEN ON THE COUNCIL

The Council on Podiatric Medical Education's Nominating Committee is seeking applications for one at-large CPME position. CPME will hold a closed ballot election to fill the position at its October 2017 meeting. The position is for a three-year term renewable up to three consecutive terms.

The council asks each applicant to describe in writing how he/she satisfies at least two of the following five eligibility requirements:

- Has been active for a period of at least two years as a director of an approved podiatric residency program.
- Has been active for a period of at least two years as an academic administrator or a full-time faculty member at an accredited college of podiatric medicine or an accredited medical institution.
- Has demonstrated leadership within the profession or distinguished himself/herself as a practitioner.
- Has served actively on one of the council's committees for a minimum of one full term.
- Has served on at least three CPME on-site evaluation teams to colleges of podiatric medicine, residency programs, or continuing education programs.

The applicant also is expected to demonstrate qualifications and experience in the following area of need:

- A faculty member at an accredited college of podiatric medicine who:
 - ✓ provides podiatric education at the college or an affiliated institution; and
 - ✓ has an active relationship with the college and its faculty.

In addition to the requirements outlined above, the candidate is encouraged to describe other podiatric and non-podiatric experiences he/she has had that strengthen the submission. Individuals seeking election to the council must submit a curriculum vitae and an application letter that addresses both the requirements **and** the area of need.
