

## CERTIFYING BOARD FEES AND OTHER ASSESSMENTS

The fee schedule was last revised during the October 2024 Council meeting with immediate implementation. Unless otherwise indicated, fees are not refundable.

Fee	Explanation of Fees and Charges
<b>Application</b>	Organizations sponsoring new certifying boards in a special area of podiatric medical practice are required to submit an initial application fee of <b>\$5,000</b> . The fee is 75 percent refundable if the organization withdraws its application for recognition prior to initial review by the Specialty Board Recognition Committee.
<b>Annual Recognition Assessment</b>	Recognized certifying boards are assessed an annual fee of <b>\$5,000 plus \$3.00</b> per diplomate.
<b>RRC Administrative</b>	Certifying boards involved in a collaborative effort through the Residency Review Committee in the evaluation of residency programs are assessed an administrative fee above and beyond the annual recognition fee. The administrative assessment for each recognized certifying board is <b>\$30,000</b> (\$15,000 for each RRC seat).
<b>Appeal of an Adverse Action</b>	Any certifying board requesting to appeal an adverse action will be billed <b>\$10,000</b> prior to the appeal. Certifying boards are billed for any additional costs over <b>\$10,000</b> following the appeal.
